BREAKOUT SESSIONS

A DAUGHTER'S PERSPECTIVE Danica Liske

Danica Liske was only 17 when her father at the age of 53 was diagnosed with early onset Alzheimer's disease. In the span of a couple years she quickly went from being Daddy's little girl to a full time caregiver. She now shares her story to give a message of hope for caregivers and to spread awareness that Alzheimer's is not an old persons' disease.

HAVE YOU EVER SEEN A CATHOLIC X-RAY? Jon Gilchrist

Of course there are no Catholic X-rays, so what exactly makes a Catholic facility... Catholic? Jon Gilchrist, an ethicist from Covenant Health in Alberta, will share his understanding of what makes Catholic healthcare unique. He will help participants to understand the mission of Catholic healthcare, as well as its role in the Canadian healthcare system.

PHYSICIAN ASSISTED SUICIDE – WHERE ARE WE TODAY? Dr. Joy Mendel

On February 6, 2015, the Supreme Court of Canada issued its landmark decision in the Carter Case, which left parliament with one year to enact new legislation concerning physician assisted suicide and euthanasia. CHAS ethicist Joy Mendel will guide participants through the Court's decision, provide a current update, and explore the impact this ruling will have on the Canadian healthcare system.

KEYNOTE ADDRESS | KENNETH PARGAMENT PH.D. The Spiritual Dimension of Health Care

In his first session, **Bridging Research and Practice**, Kenneth Pargament will provide an overview of the current status of research on spirituality and health and its implications for clinical practice and better patient outcomes. His presentation will consider the reasons for the historic divide between religion, spirituality, and health, and it will note how 25 years of study now create a strong evidence-based rationale for spiritually integrated health care. This sets the stage for Dr. Pargament's second session, **Cultivating Sacred Moments in Health Care**, which will focus on sacred moments as an ingredient in the healing process, not only for patients and their families but also for providers themselves.
