As God's beloved, we are awakened to our innate capacity to transform our pain and become wounded healers.

Challenging Catholic thought and perspective on the value and view of the human person, how do we stand firm in our ministry of Catholic health care in our increasingly secular context? How does this change the conversation at the supper table with our friends and families? Dr. Markwell will offer insights and reflections from her experience as Executive Director of the Centre for Clinical Ethics in Toronto, and now from her current role as Ethics Consultant for the Catholic Health Alliance of Canada.
